4. Nominations, with supporting documentation, must be clearly marked as "Philanthropist of the Year Nominee," mailed to the Community Foundation of Carroll County Office, and postmarked by August 15th.
5. Nominee must be 18 years or younger on August 15th

Selection Criteria:

Please attach responses to the following criteria requirements in a summary format of no more than three typed pages. **IMPORTANT:** The Awards Committee will not accept as complete any nomination which relies solely on resumes, newspaper articles, annual reports or the like, in substitution for concise responses to the criteria outlined below.

1. Description in detail of what the nominee did, including goals, process, budget (if relevant) and other people involved in the process (adult leaders or advisors, etc.), and of the time, talent and/or treasure the youth gave for the common good and the results that were achieved.
2. Description of the impact the nominee had on the community, including numbers of people involved, financial impact, organizations helped, etc.
3. Description of broad, long-term benefits of contributions to the community. Will the project(s) be ongoing, and has the nominee considered next steps or is working on other projects?
4. Description of participation in other non-profit organizations, other than the nominating organization.
5. Evidence that the project(s) can serve as a prototype for others, or is easily replicable in other communities.
