Vaccines will be offered on site using a certified vet tech.

Suspected illness issues will be referred to veterinarian

For clients with Food stamps and/or public assistance: Pet food will be provided depending on supply

Pet products such as collars, carriers, flea products will be offered either free or with a substantial discount, again, depending on supply.

For those who are able to donate, a nominal donation of \$1.00 to \$10.00 will be asked.
