

WHAT IS THE ANIMAL WELLNESS FUND?

The Animal Wellness Fund provides spay/neuter services and limited wellness inoculations at low or no cost to qualified pet owners. We also provide pet food to low income pet owners at low or no cost.

In addition we partner with local shelter/rescue groups and the Carroll County Humane Society to aid in ensuring the health of local pets and to provide peace of mind for their owners.

Other Animal Wellness Fund Characteristics:

- Vaccines will be offered on site using a certified veterinary technician
- Pet Food will be provided, depending on supply, for clients with Food stamps and/or public assistance
- Pet products such as collars, carriers, and flea products will be offered either free or with a substantial discount depending on supply.
- Addresses strays, unwanted litters and illnesses
- Vouchers will be offered for spay and neuter services so that the client may use the veterinarian of their choice and location

THE BENEFITS

- Provides support for local pet owners
- Allows pets to be spayed and neutered for little or no cost if the owner does not have to funds to do so themselves
- Relieves the pressure of local animal shelters and the humane society for doing these tasks
- Provides a safe environment for all pets and their owners
- Helps clients keep and maintain the health of their pet
- Allows clients to maintain a relationship with their pet(s) to ensure that they will be able to keep their pet(s) no matter their financial circumstances
