CRITERIA

THE MD HOOPMASTERS SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: The purpose of the MD HOOPMASTERS SCHOLARSHIP is to provide a one time scholarship for a current MD Hoopmasters or Lady Hoopmaster. The scholarship will honor an individual who has shown excellence on and off the court, in the classroom and who meets the criteria established for this scholarship

FUND SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A. FUNDS will be awarded to an applicant who meets the following criteria:
1. The student will be a current member of the MD Hoopmasters graduating class and be in good standing. Good standing means that the applicant will have completed the full AAU season prior to their senior year.
 2. The student will have been accepted at an accredited college, university or other institute of higher learning.
 3. The student will have maintained an unweight GPA of 3.0 for his or her high school career and have college worthy SAT scores.
 4. The student will have met their 75+ hours of community service
 5. The student will have demonstrated great character, leadership, focus and the desire to succeed. This should be demonstrated in the required essay.
- B. The administration of the FUND shall be as follows:
1. The recipient(s) shall be selected by the Donor's MD Hoopmaster's scholarship advisory committee and be approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County. Donor reserves the right to make the award presentation.
 2. The initial scholarship amount will be \$250.

3. The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to the desired college or university and applied directly to the student's tuition and books. The monies shall not be remitted to the scholarship winner.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF FUND

The Community Foundation will transmit a check made payable to the institutions of higher learning chosen on or about August 1 of each year. The transfers will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD

- A. The successful student recipients will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner and the funds may be commingled with other funds of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
