

The purpose of the Taylor W. Barnes memorial scholarship is to honor Taylor's memory, and provide a scholarship for a graduating Carroll County Student who is pursuing further education in Farming or agriculture related fields. Taylor grew up loving life on his parent's farm and the farming community. Although he was severely dyslexic and dealt with ADHD, he was gifted with great mechanical abilities.



Getting his elementary and middle school education at the Gemicy School for Dyslexic Students, he learned to cope and deal with his handicaps. His high school education at Francis Scott Key and the Diesel Tech and Welding programs at the Career and Technology Center prepared him to attend college. Taylor got an AA degree with honors, specializing in the John Deere Agricultural Technology Program at North East Iowa Community College.

He was employed by Gladhill Tractor Mart in Frederick, did a lot of side work, ultimately fulfilling his childhood dream of opening his own shop. Taylor had a thriving business when he became ill, due to the onset of depression and anxiety. Through no fault of his own, he was hounded for four years by over prescribed medications to the point he was no longer able to work in the successful business he had built. On August 8, 2020, at age 33 he lost the battle with medications and depression. Being unable to do the work he loved; he took his own life.



As a gifted, caring thoughtful Christian, he hurts no more, and is now in the company of his Heavenly Father and loving family members. Taylor helped many people, from the goodness of his heart. We know he is pleased to be helping a student toward his or her goals.

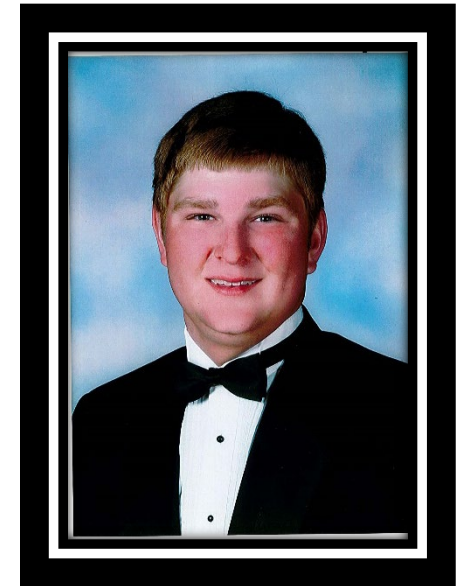
